Veeder Root Day of Caring



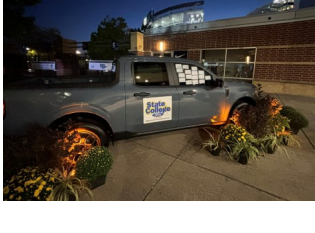

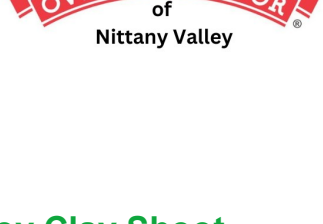
CvC Reverse Car Drawing



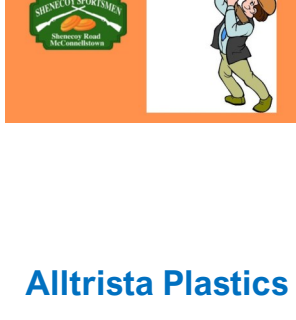

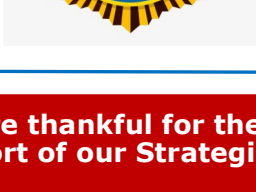
Community Foundation & UPMC Altoona Foundation Grants
